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I) Introduction

Full of features for designing a perfect checkout success page, **Magento 2 Checkout Success Page** extension is the ultimate way to improve post purchase experience, maintain contact with customers and boost your sales.

- Easily customize checkout success page with drag & drop
- 20+ elements
- 5 pre-built templates
- Show different success pages by conditions
- Display coupon codes
- Dynamic variables
- Fully responsive
- 100% compatible with [Magezon Page Builder](#).

Checkout Success Page extension works based on rules to display different success pages. In the backend, you need to create a rule that comes with a custom success page. Customers with orders satisfying this rule will land on corresponding success page.

You can add unlimited rules to display as many success pages as wanted.

NOTE: Checkout Success Page is developed on a core builder based on which we've built all of our builder extensions. The core builder includes elements and settings that all builder extensions have in common. For detailed guide, please visit:



In this guide, we'll focus on elements and settings that are specific to **Checkout Success Page** extension.

II) Where to Find Extension

After installing the extension, navigate to **Marketing > Checkout Success Page > Rules** where you can add a new rule to display a specific success page and view all the rules you created.

- You can view all the rules that you created in a grid:

1. Rule Information

- **Enable Rule:** turn on the button to activate the rule.
- **Rule Name:** enter name for the rule.
- **Store View:** choose store views to apply the rule.
- **Customer Groups:** choose customer groups to apply the rule.
- **From...To...:** specify the date range to apply the rule.
- **Priority:** define the order of priority for the rule by entering a number. If an order satisfies multiple rules, the success page of the rule with smallest number in **Priority** field will be displayed.







2. When to Display

Where you set conditions to display the rule using Magento 2 product conditions:

When To Display

Apply the rule only if the following conditions are met (leave blank for all products).

If **ALL** of these conditions are **TRUE** :

- If an item is **FOUND** in the cart with **ALL** of these conditions true: 
 - Category is **20** 
 - Quantity in cart **equals or greater than 5** 
 - 
 - Shipping Country is **United States**

3. What to Display

3.1 Coupon Block

Where you set coupon codes to display on your success page.



Go to Marketing > Cart Price Rules to register a rule. The rule should be set as a Specific Coupon

Coupon Pattern *

Different coupon codes will be auto generated for each customer based on the pattern you enter in this field. The pattern follows this rule:
[3AN] - 3 alphanumeric characters
[3A] - 3 alpha characters
[3N] - 3 numeric characters
Eg: THANKYOU-[2AN]-[3A]-[4N] => **THANKYOU-H7-GED-3428**

- **Enable Coupon:** turn on the button to activate coupon code.
- **Select Rule:** select a specific cart price rule from the drop-down list. To create a new cart price rule, please go to **Marketing > Promotions > Cart Price Rules**.

Use Auto Generation

If you select and save the rule you will be able to generate multiple coupon codes.

Here, remember to set the rule as a **Specific Coupon**. The new rule that you've created will appear in the drop-down for you to choose.

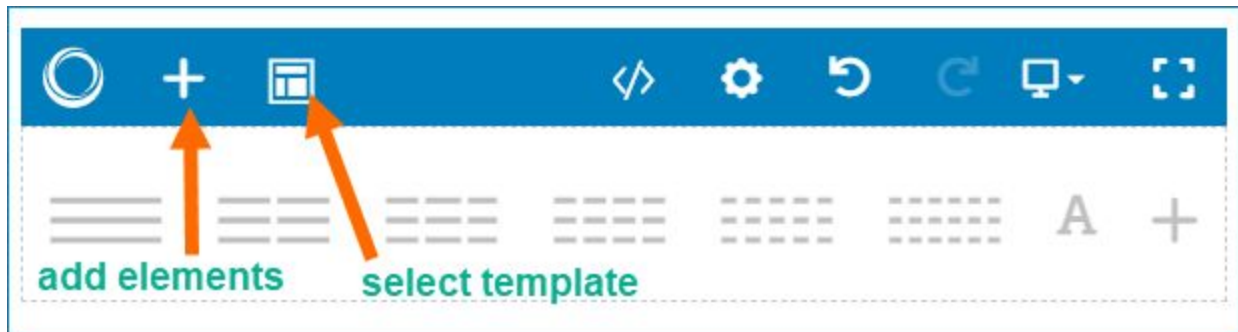
If you enter a fixed **Coupon Code**, then this code will be displayed in the success page. If you choose to **Use Auto Generation**, coupon codes will be auto created based on the **Coupon Pattern**.

- **Coupon Pattern:** enter the coupon pattern based on which different coupon codes will be auto generated for each customer. The pattern follows this rule:
 - [3AN] - 3 alphanumeric characters
 - [3A] - 3 alpha characters
 - [3N] - 3 numeric characters

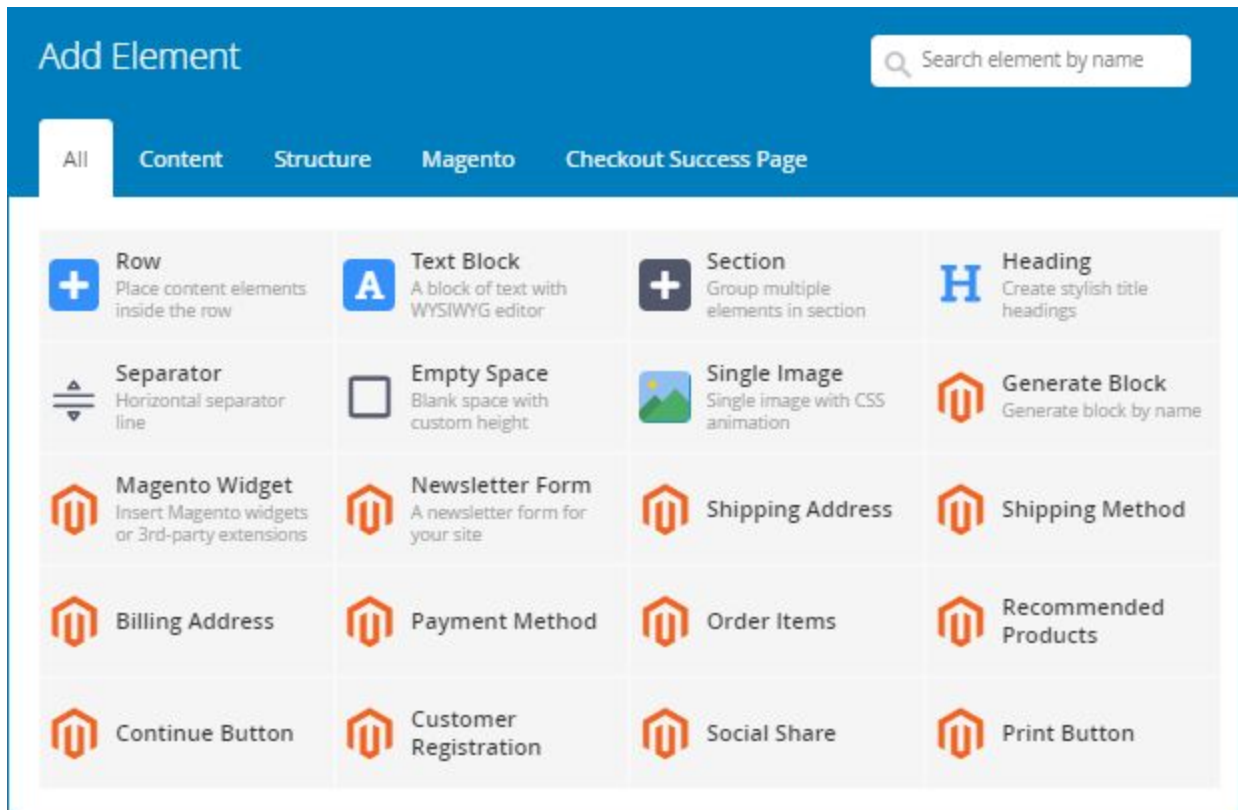

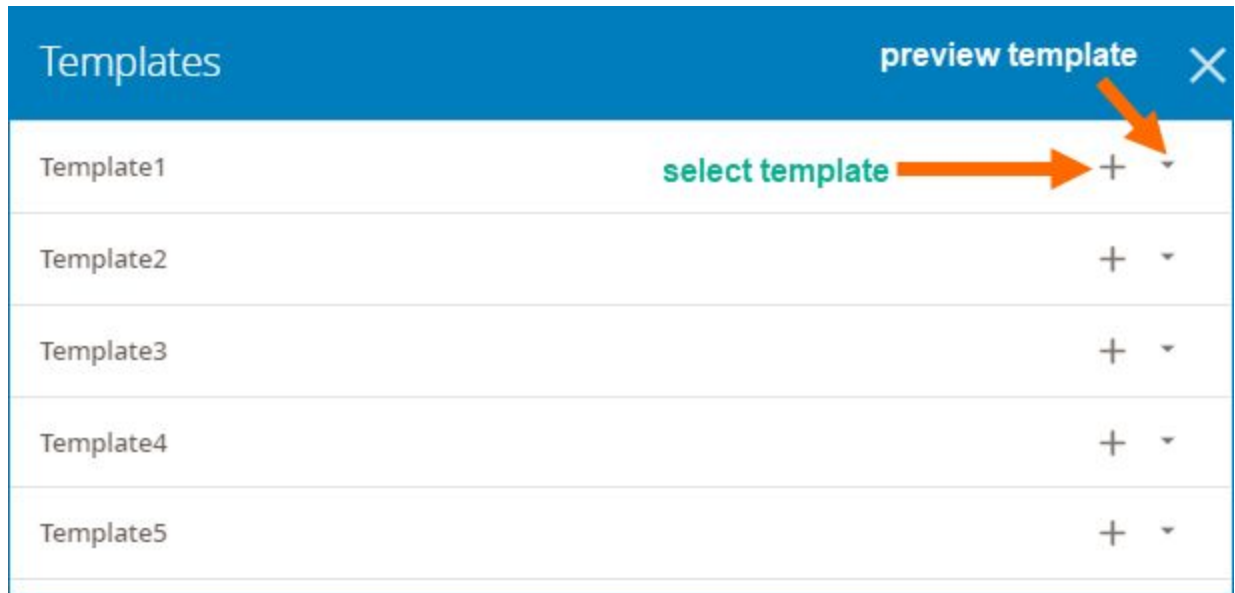
Where you create and customize success page for the rule:



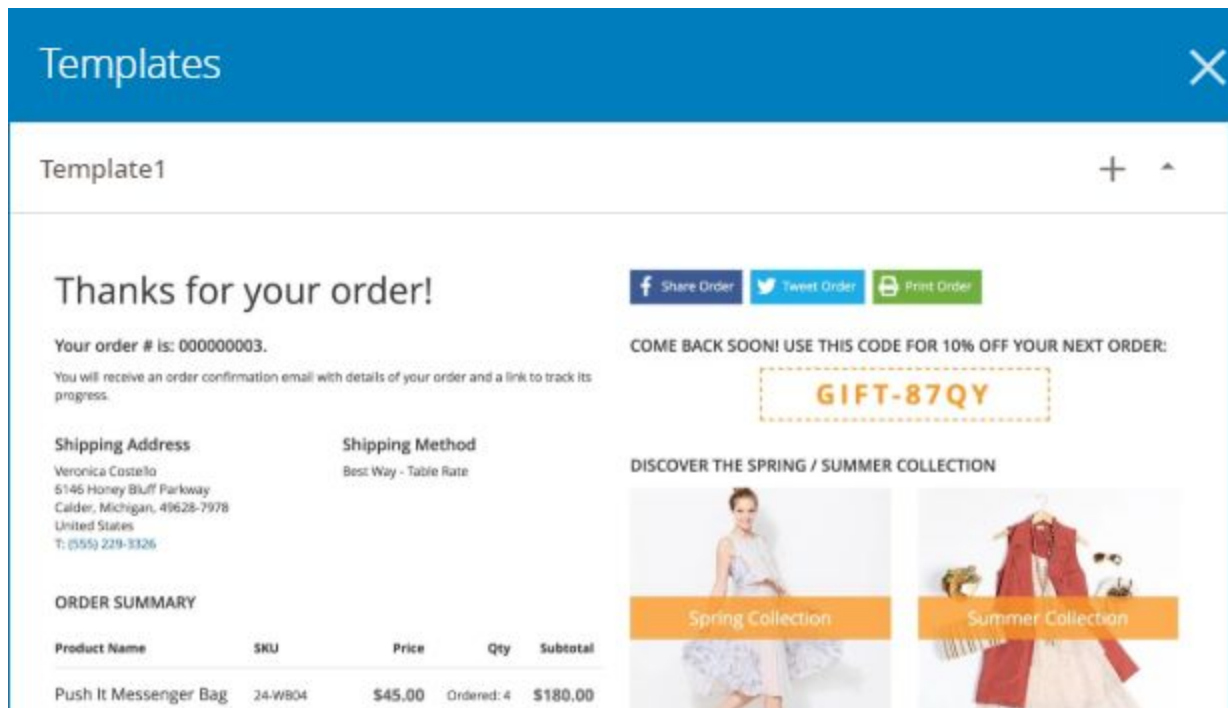
- Click the plus icon to add elements. You can view all elements in the popup like this:



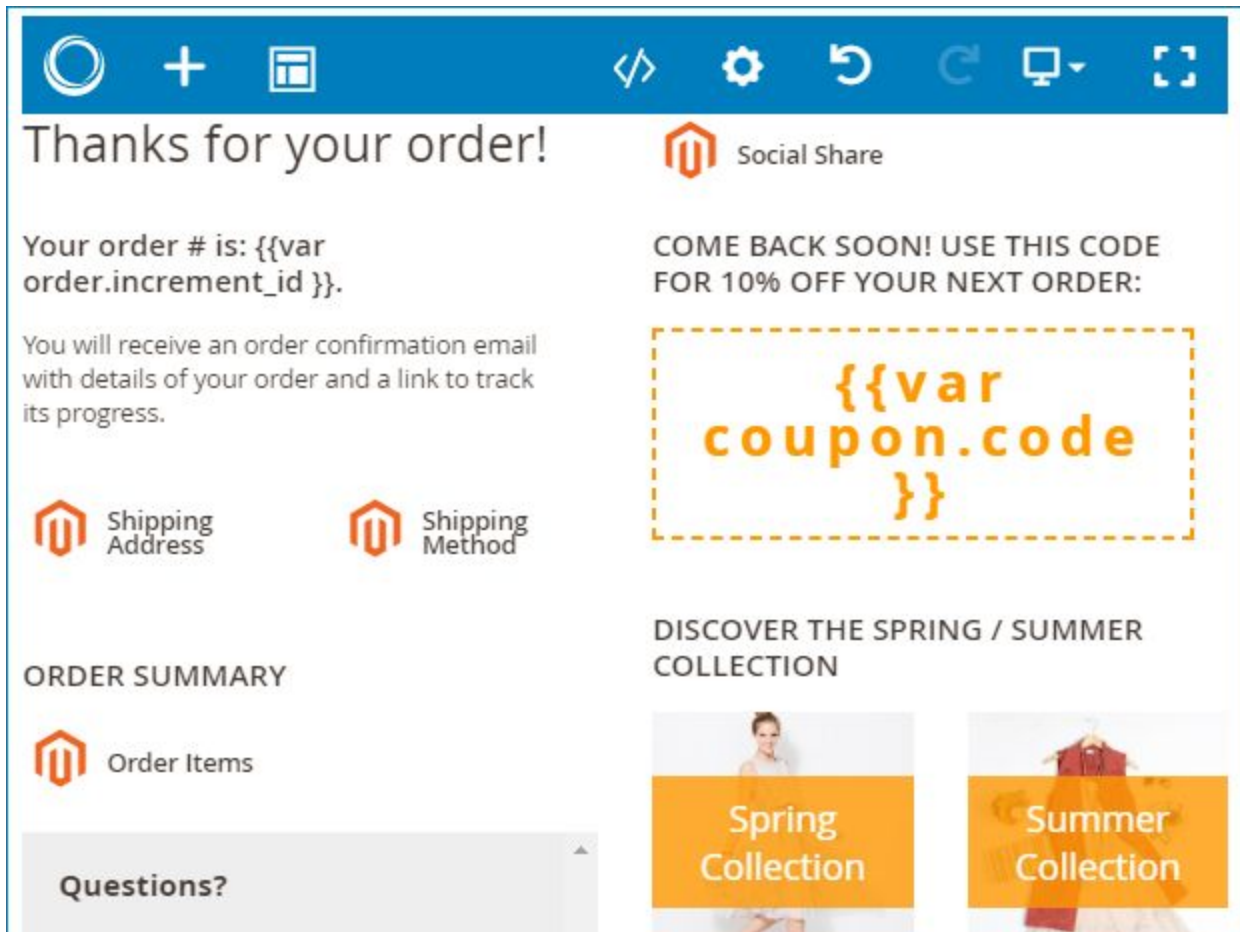
- Click the icon next to plus icon the select a template. You'll see all templates in a popup:



- Click drop-down icon to preview a template, like this:




- Click plus icon to select the template. The selected template will be displayed in the builder section and you can customize it the way you want.



NOTE: Checkout Success Page extension allows you to insert variables in builder section to add more information to the success page. Here are some common variables:


- `{{var order.increment_id }}` - insert order ID.
- `{{var total|raw }}` - insert order total value.
- `{{var order.getCreatedAtFormatted(2)|raw }}` - insert order date.
- `{{var coupon.code }}` - insert coupon code that you've set in [Coupon Block](#) section.

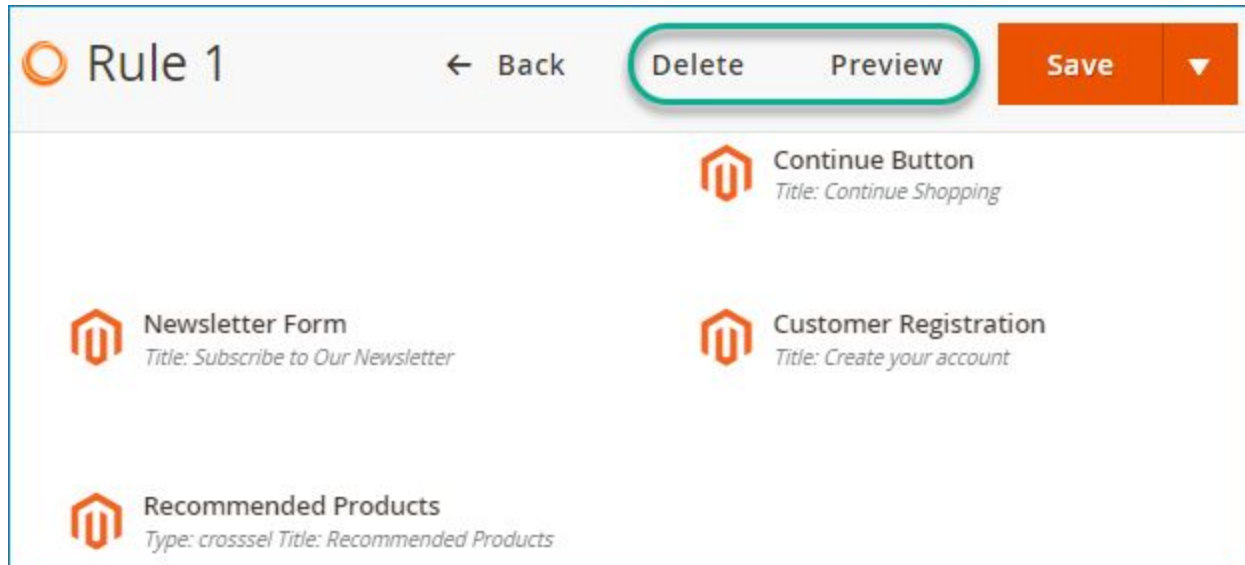
