## I) Introduction

This document is the User Guide for Header & Footer Builder. It describes the extension functionality and provides some tips for a quick start.

**Header & Footer Builder** is an EASY-TO-USE extension letting you shape these blocks in minutes. No coding skills needed, just make your own headers and footers using intuitive drag & drop interface.

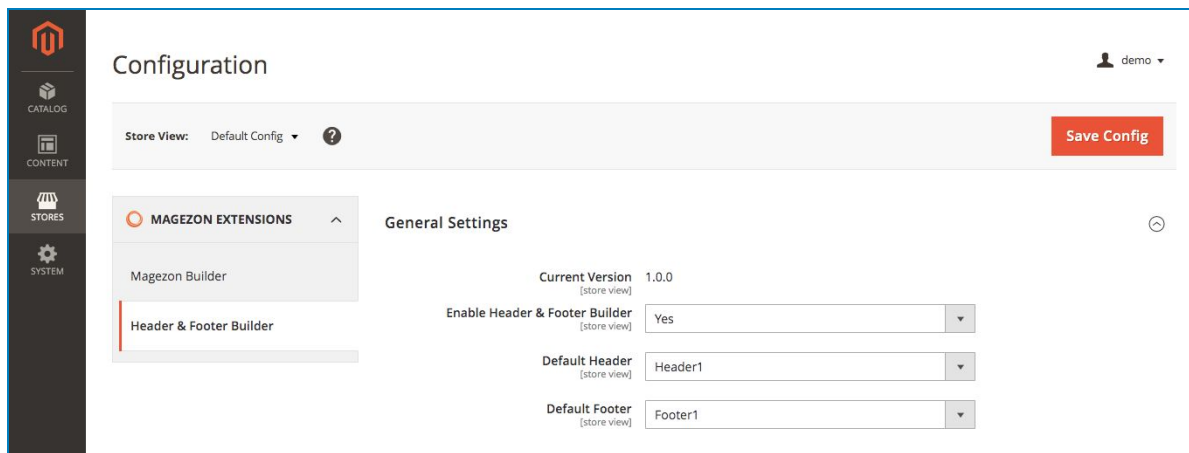
Header & Footer' builder is developed on a core builder based on which we've built all builder extensions. The core builder includes elements and settings that all builder extensions have in common. For details, please visit:

In this guide, we'll focus on elements and settings that are specific to Header & Footer Builder.

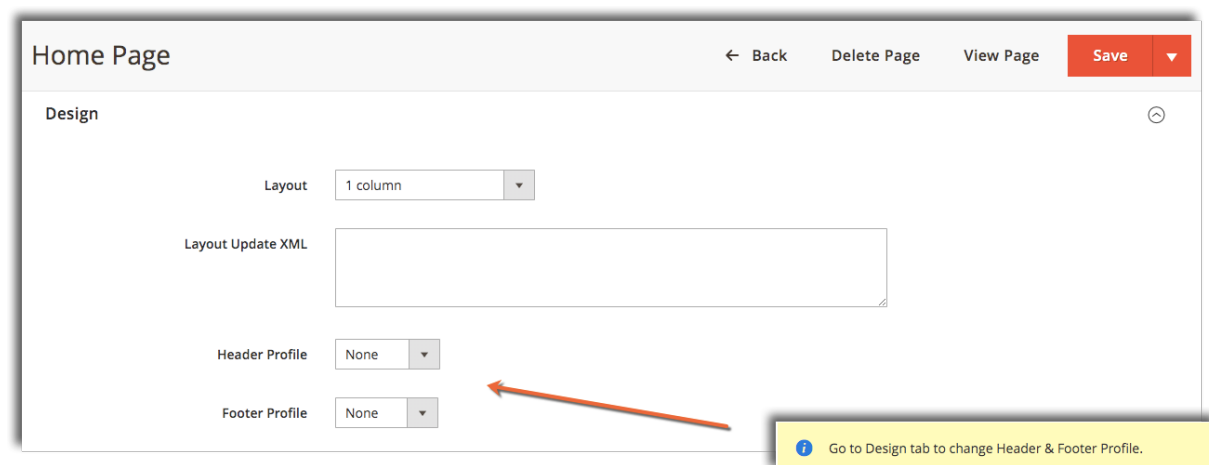
## II) Configuration

Once the extension has been installed, click on **Stores > Configuration**. The interface will look like this.



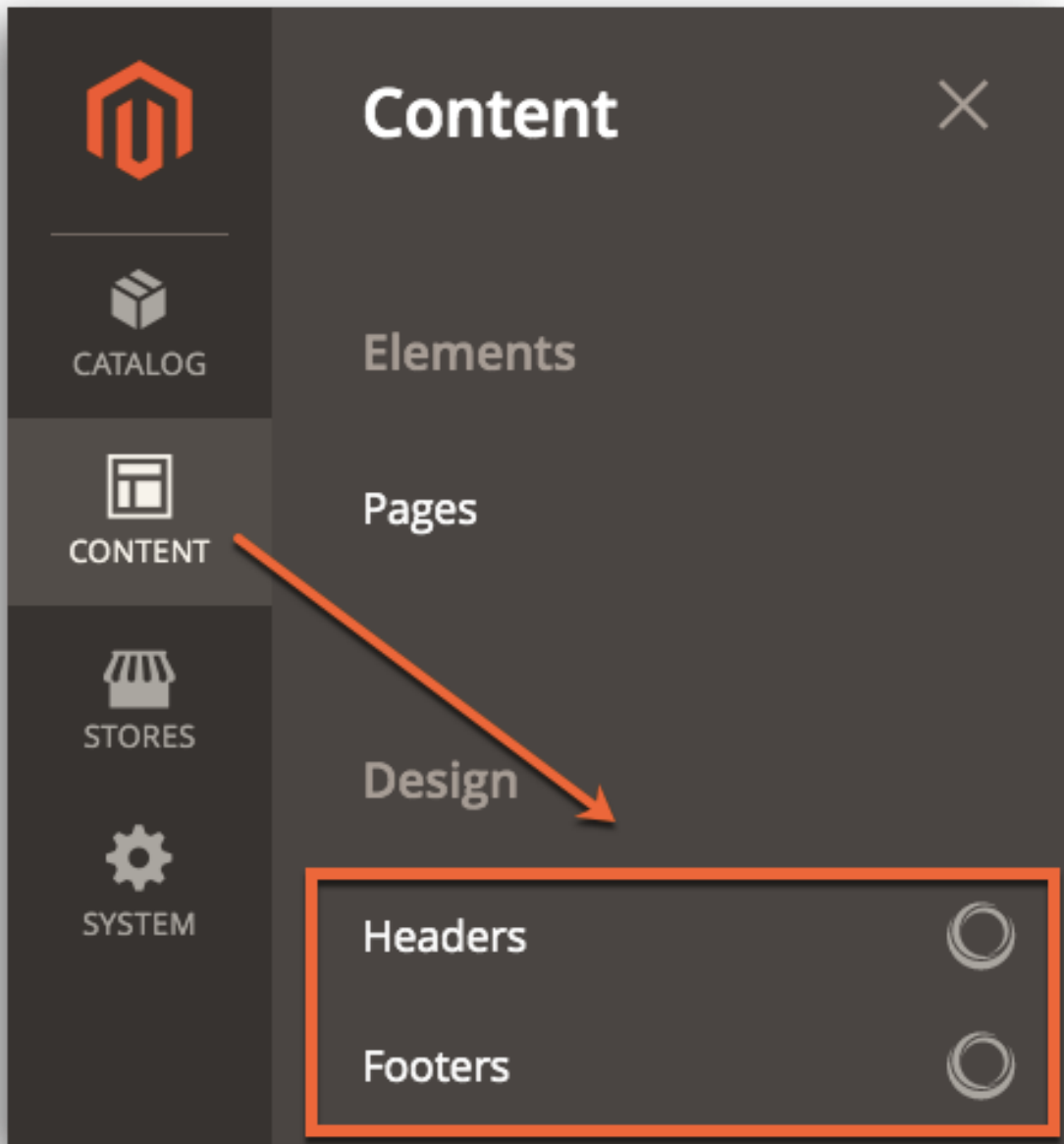
- Choose **Yes** to **Enable Header & Footer Builder**
- Select **Default Header/ Footer** using the drop-down list.

**Note:** This setting will be applied for all the pages in your site. It means default header/footer chosen appears all over the site. To set different header/footer for individual page, come to its editing interface, select the desired ones from **Design** tab.




## III) Header & Footer Builder

The section Headers & Footers will appear in the Content menu. To go to admin grid of Header & Footer Builder extension, navigate to **Content > Headers** or **Content > Footers**



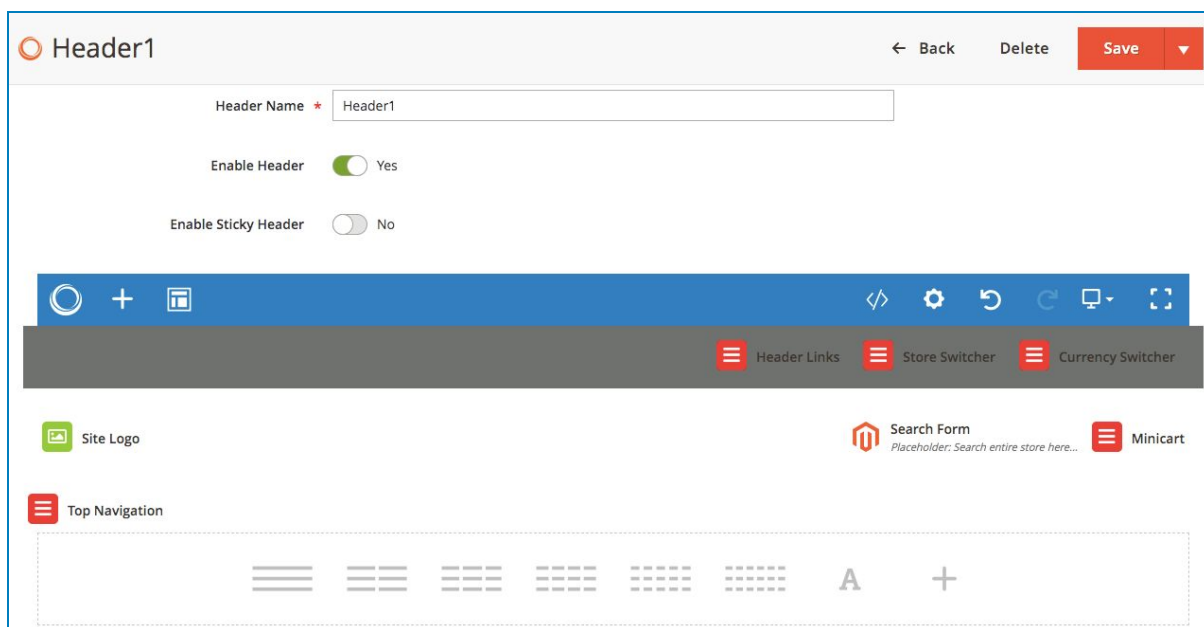
To go on builder interface, choose the header or footer you would like to edit then click

**Select > Edit.**

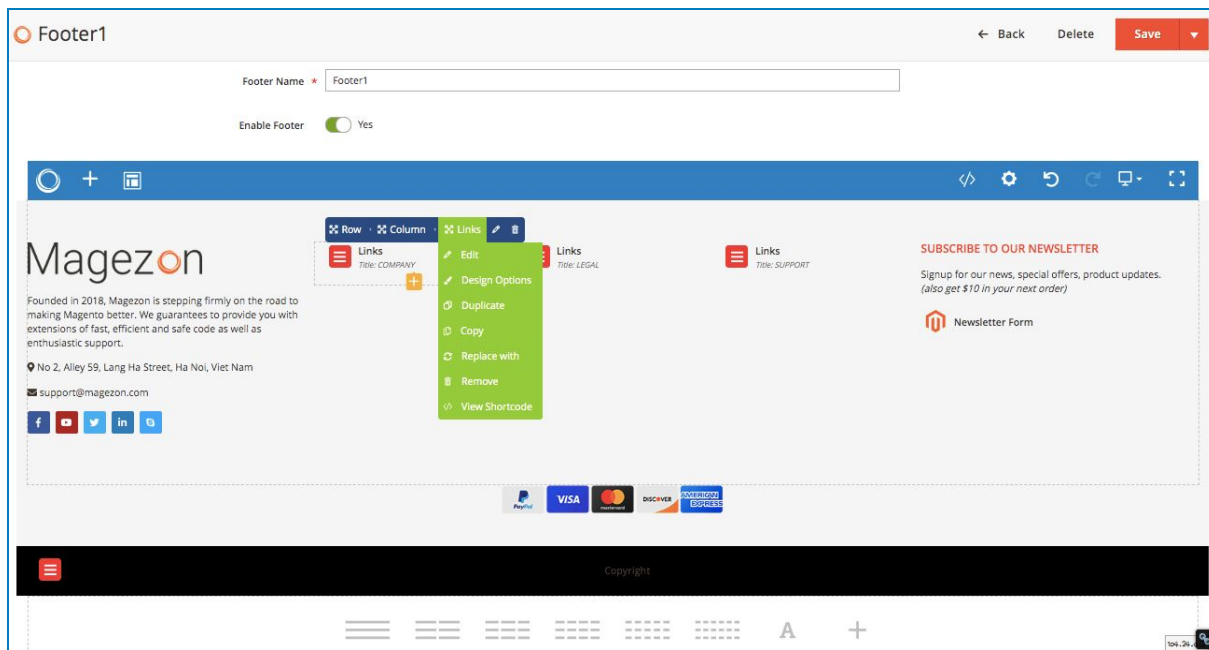
This case, we choose **Header 1** and **Footer 1**.

From left to right of the editor interface, we have some buttons with their function like below:

- **Magezon Logo** drives you to the official Header & Footer Builder page.
- **Plus** button lets add new items into the header/ footer.
- **Template** button shows the list of common predefined headers or footers list.
- **Coding** button lets you copy and paste the code to save time configuring.
- **Setting** button is useful for developers to customize.
- **Undo** and **redo** whenever you make a mistake.
- **Responsive** button (with 5 common devices listed) lets you choose the screen mode to configure individually.
- **Widen** button lets you see the builder in full screen and configure in a bigger viewport.



- Enter the **Header Name**.
- Decide whether to display the header or not by turning one **Enable Header** button.
- **Enable Sticky Header** to stick it to the top even while scrolling.



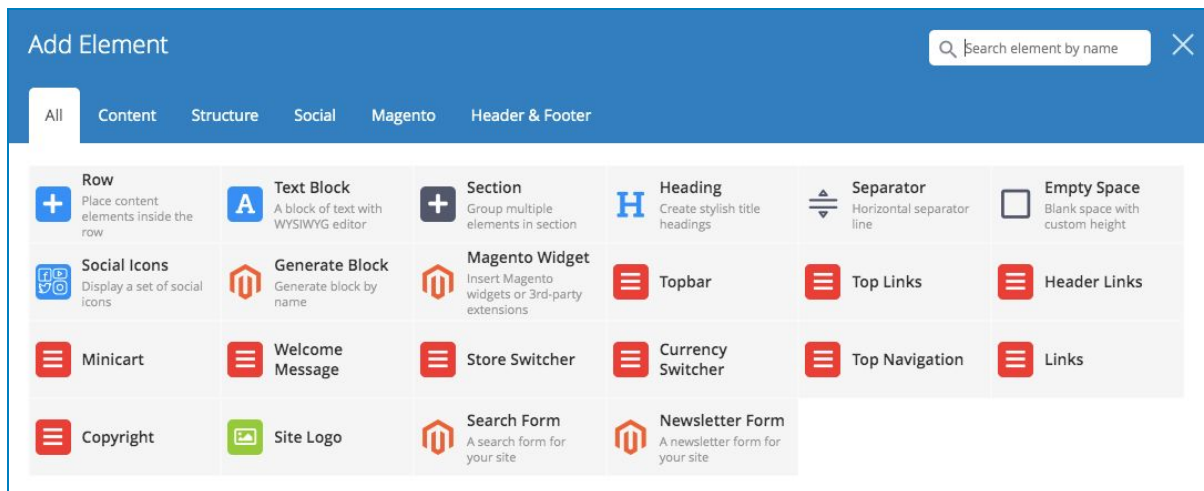
- Enter **Footer Name**
- Display footer by switching **Enable Footer** button.



## IV) Elements list

Click on the **Plus** button to see what can be added into your header/ footer.

The list of 22 elements supported will be shown like follow:



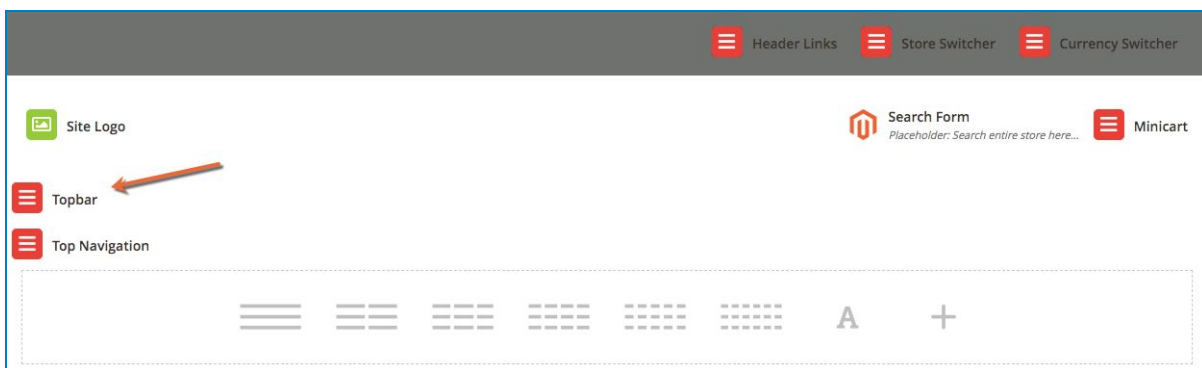
- **Row, Text Block, Section, Heading, Separator, Empty Space, Generate Block, Magento Widget** are the core elements that are described carefully in this [guide](#).

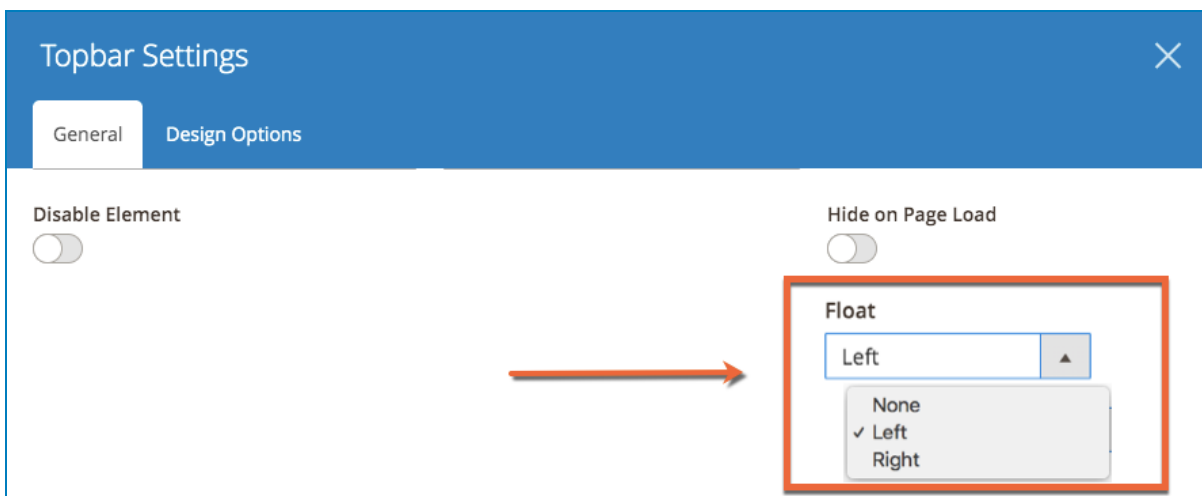
## V) Specific elements

### 1. Topbar

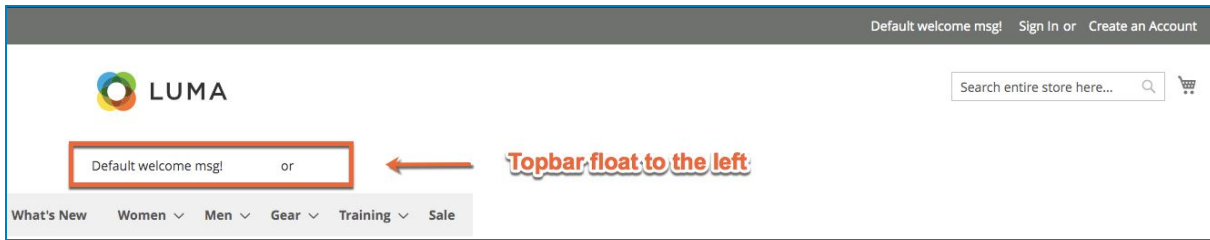
We will use **Header 1** to show the elements' functions and the changes in the frontend. Common settings of Topbar is mentioned in [Magezon Core Builder Guide](#), and will not be explained in this guide. Add **Topbar** element above the navigation bar like this:



When it comes to Topbar's specific setting, we get:



Then see how Topbar look in the storefront:



What about change the **Float** to **Right**?

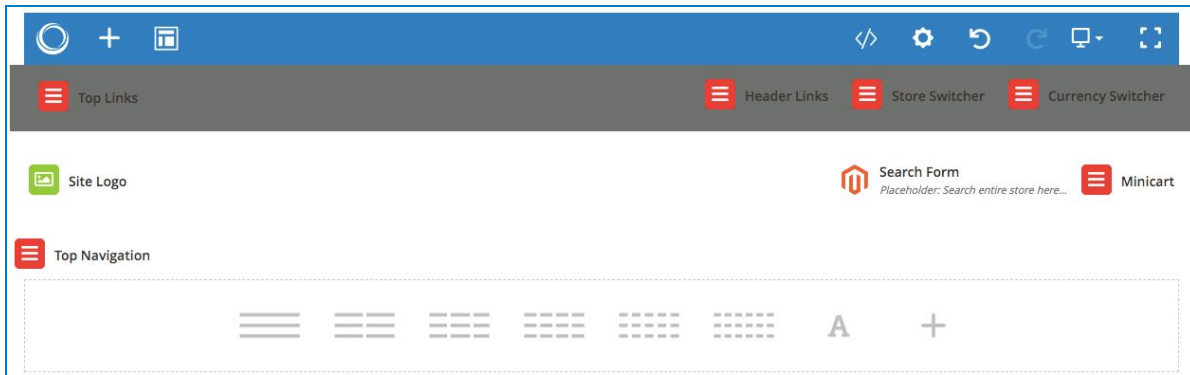


When setting to **None**, the default position of Topbar will be in the right

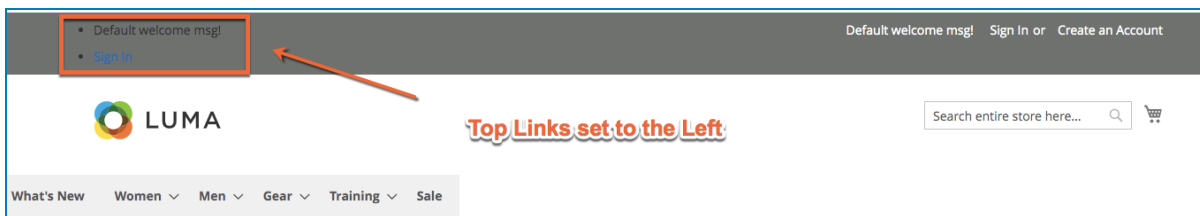


## 2. Top Links

Just like Topbar element, Top Links has no new settings except **Float** field. Try this setting in the backend (Set Top Links **Float** to **Left**)

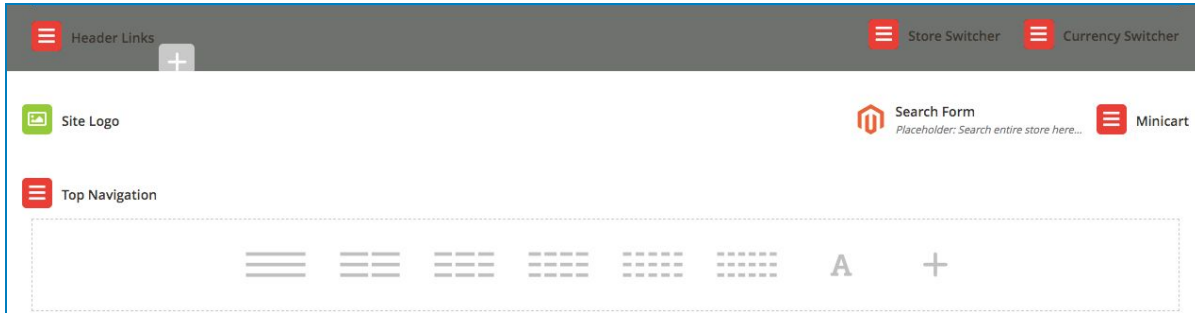


And this is how it looks in the front:



## 3. Header Links

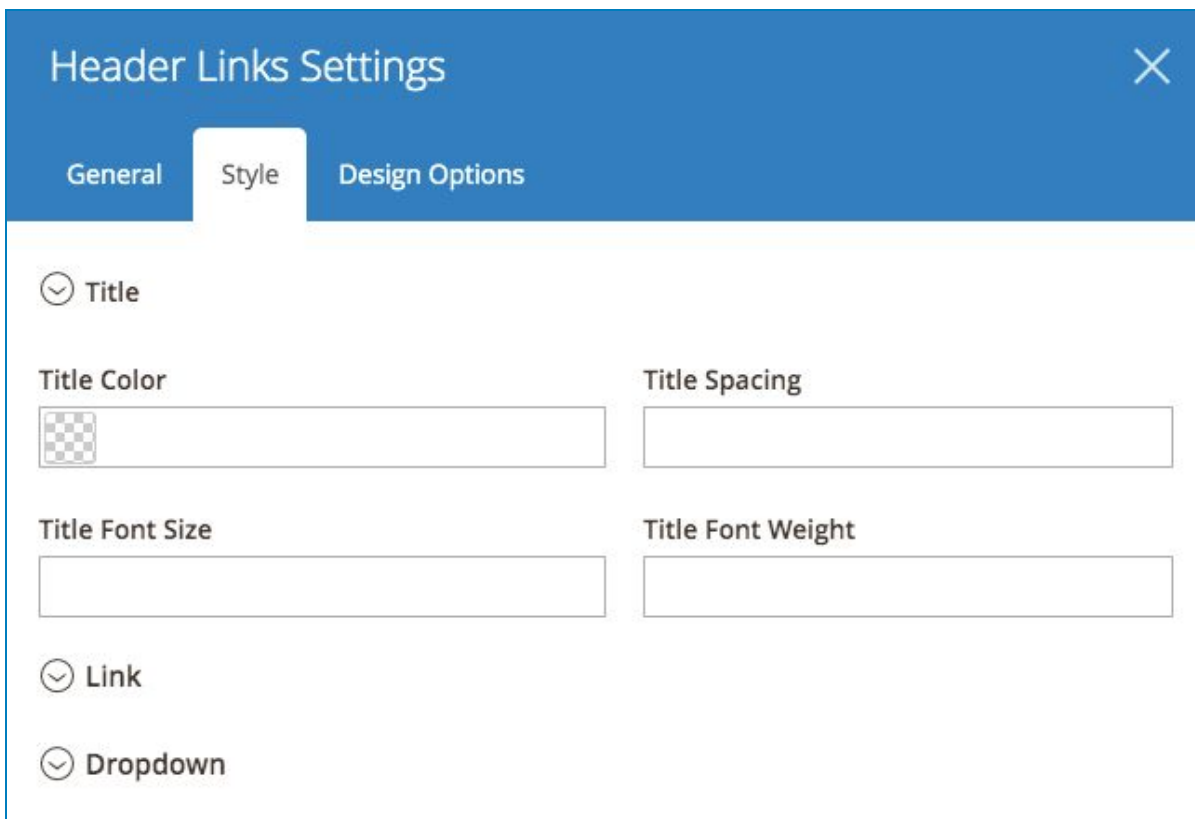
Add Header Links, and set **Float** to the **Left** like this:

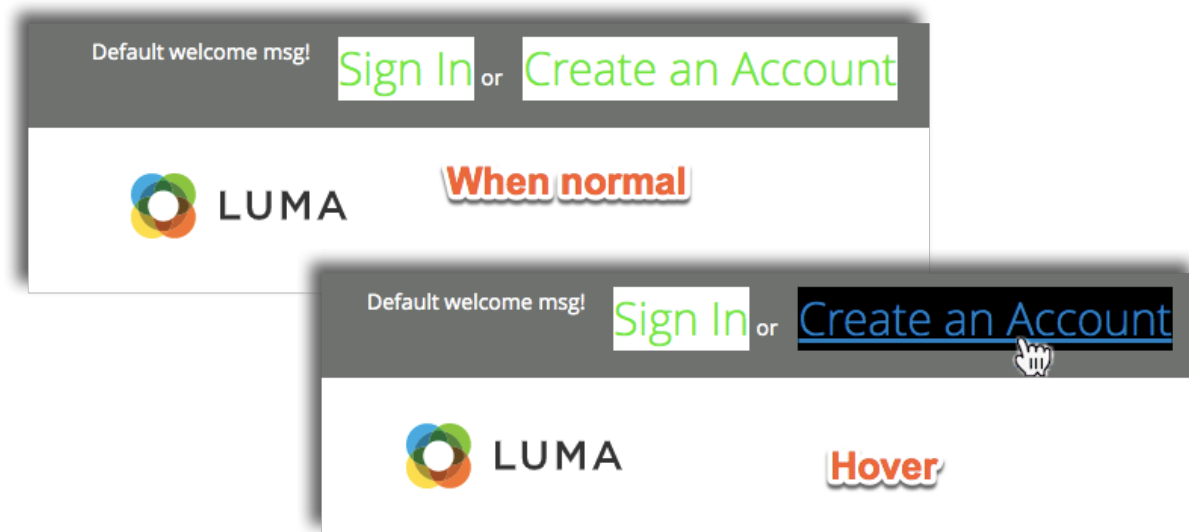

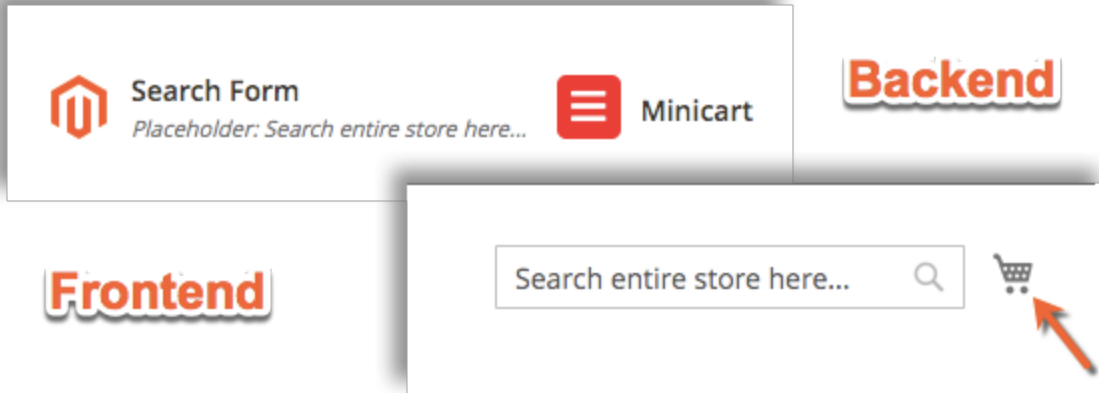

Add Mini Cart and set its **Float** to the **Right**:





Set the color for the text of Welcome message like this





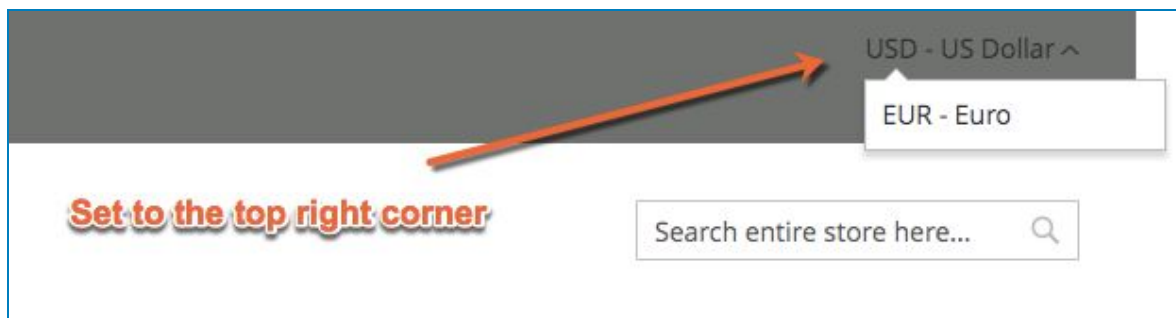


