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I) Introduction

Login & Registration Page for Magento 2 extension allows using drag & drop to build layout for login & registration pages without touching any line of code.

- Customize login & registration page layout with drag & drop
- 10+ elements
- Save time with pre-built templates
- Fully responsive
- 100% compatible with: Ultimo theme, Porto theme & [Magezon Page Builder](#).

NOTE: Login & Registration Page extension was developed on a core builder based on which we built all of our builder extensions. The core builder includes elements and settings that all builder extensions have in common. 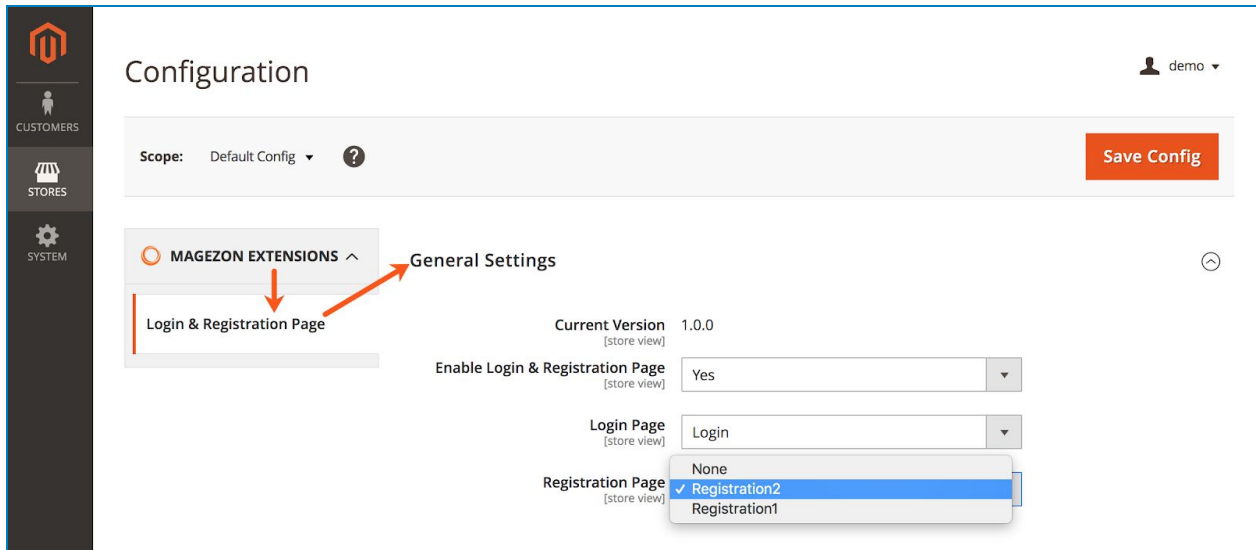
In this guide, we'll focus on elements and settings that are specific to **Login & Registration Page** extension.

II) Where to Find Extension

After installing the extension, navigate to **Store > Settings > Configuration**.

On the left panel, span **MAGEZON EXTENSIONS** and choose **Login & Registration Page**.


On the right section, you can see **General Settings** that include:



- **Current Version** of the extension.
- **Enable Login & Registration Page**: choose **Yes/No** to enable/disable the extension.
- **Login Page**: select a layout that's applied to the login page on frontend. Choose None to keep the default layout.
- **Registration Page**: select a layout that's applied to the registration page on frontend. Choose None to keep the default layout.

III) Create Layouts

Navigate to **Customers > Login & Registration Pages** to land on the page where you can create a new layout and manage all layouts you created.

- To create a new layout, click **Add New Page** button on the top-right corner. The edit page of the new layout looks like this:





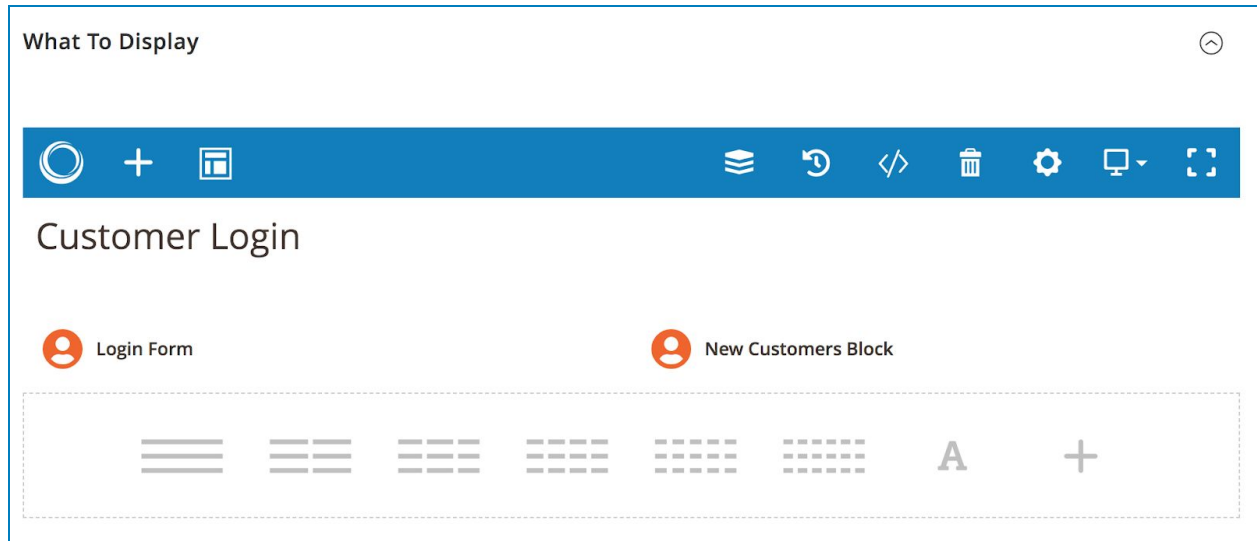

What To Display 

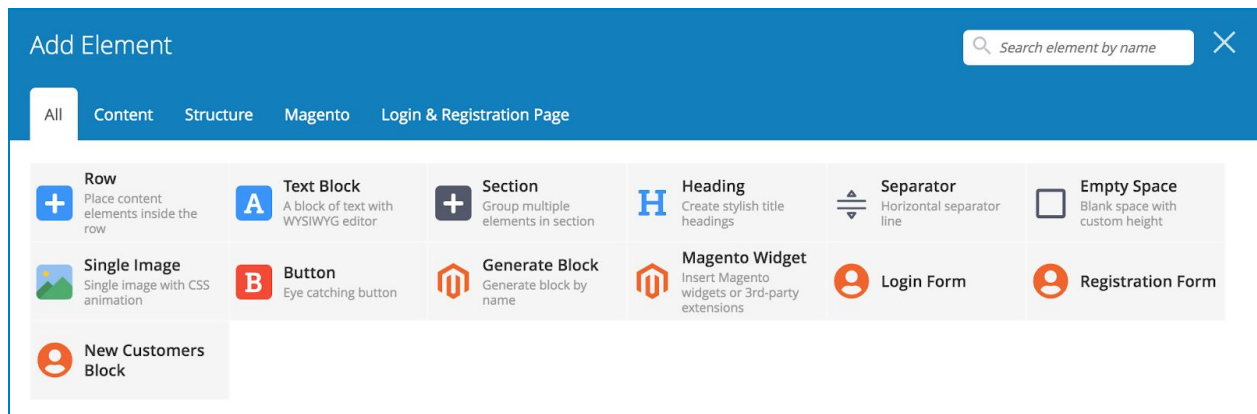
- **Page Name:** enter layout name.
- **Type:** choose page type to apply the layout with 2 options: Login or Registration.
E.g. If you choose Login, the login page on frontend will be displayed in this layout.
- **Layout:** Choose layout type from 6 options:
 - Empty
 - 1 column
 - 2 columns with left bar
 - 2 columns with right bar
 - 3 columns
 - 1 column full width (this layout is available only after the extension is installed).

2. What to Display

Where you create and customize layout for login/registration pages using drag & drop interface.



- Click the plus icon on the top bar to add elements from a popup:





- Click the icon next to plus icon to view and select a pre-built template.



4. Button

You can use this element to add Create an Account button.


- General tab:



- **Text:** add text inside the button.
- **Link:** click **Select Url** button to add a link.
- **Add Icon:** add icon inside the button. Choose **Icon** from 2 **Icon Library:** Awesome 5 & Open Iconic.

- **Element Auto Width:** If you have multiple buttons on different rows that are next to each other, turn on this function to display these buttons on the same row.
- **Icon Position:** display the icon on the **Left/Right** of button text.



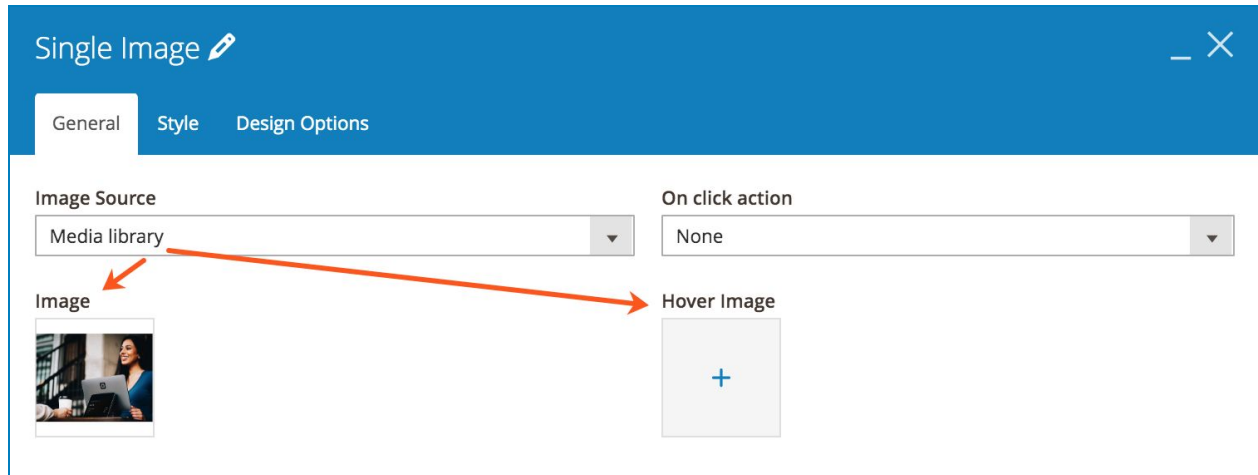

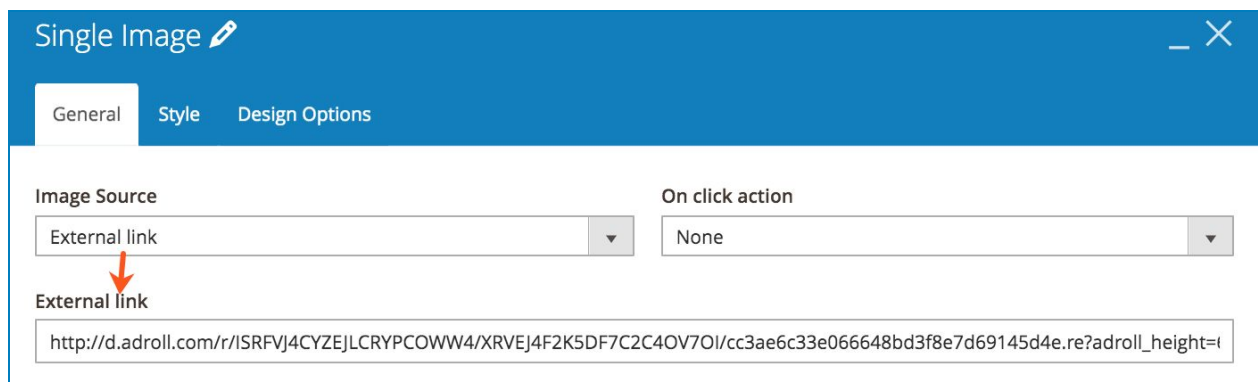

- **Image Source:** add image from Media library or use External link.

>> If you set Image Source as Media library, you'll add **Image** and **Hover Image** (the image that is displayed when you hover over the main **Image**).

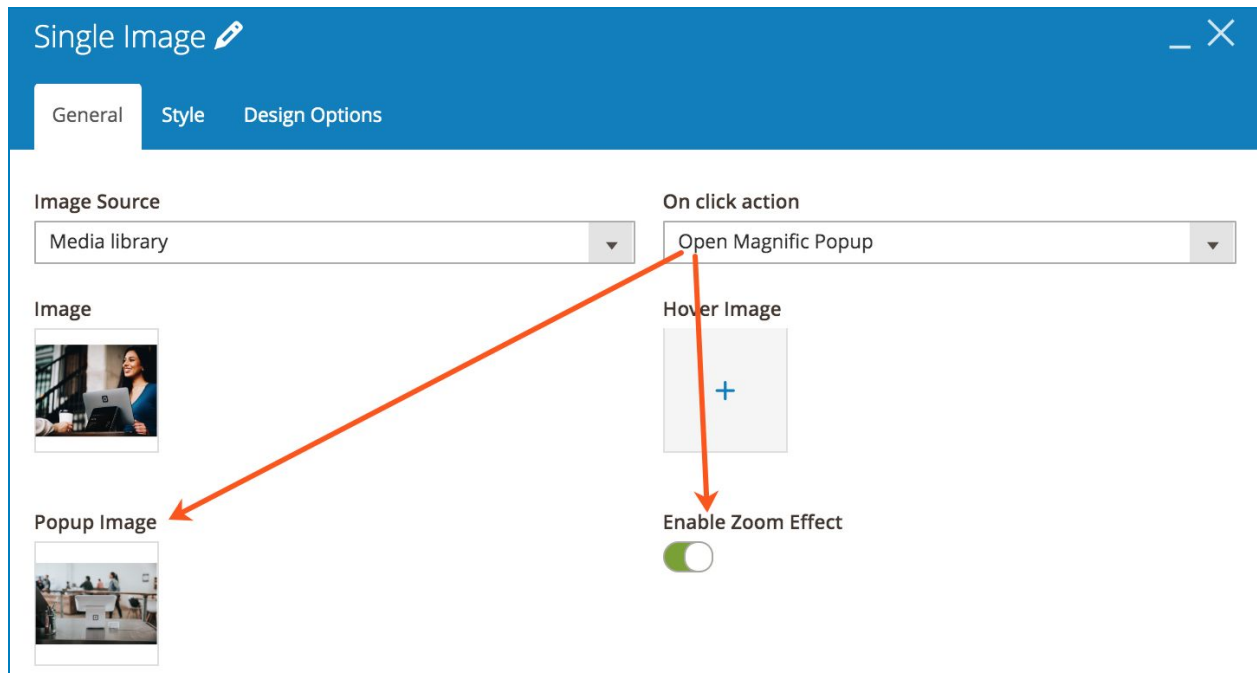


>> If you set Image Source as External link, you'll add image address in **External link** field.

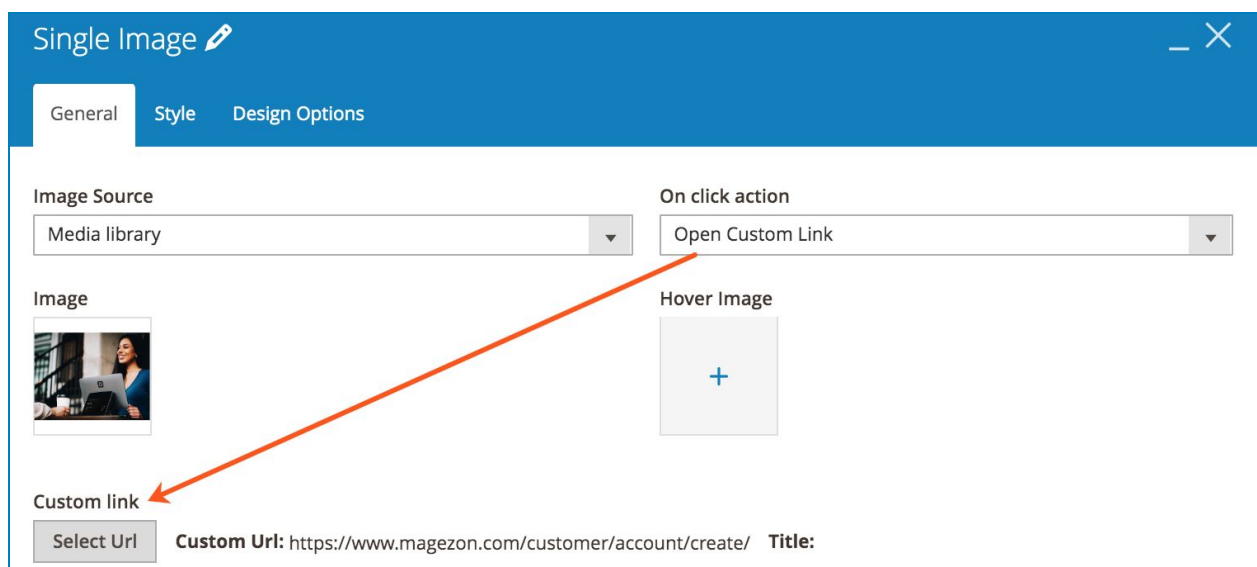


- **On click action:** specify what will happen when the image is clicked. You can:

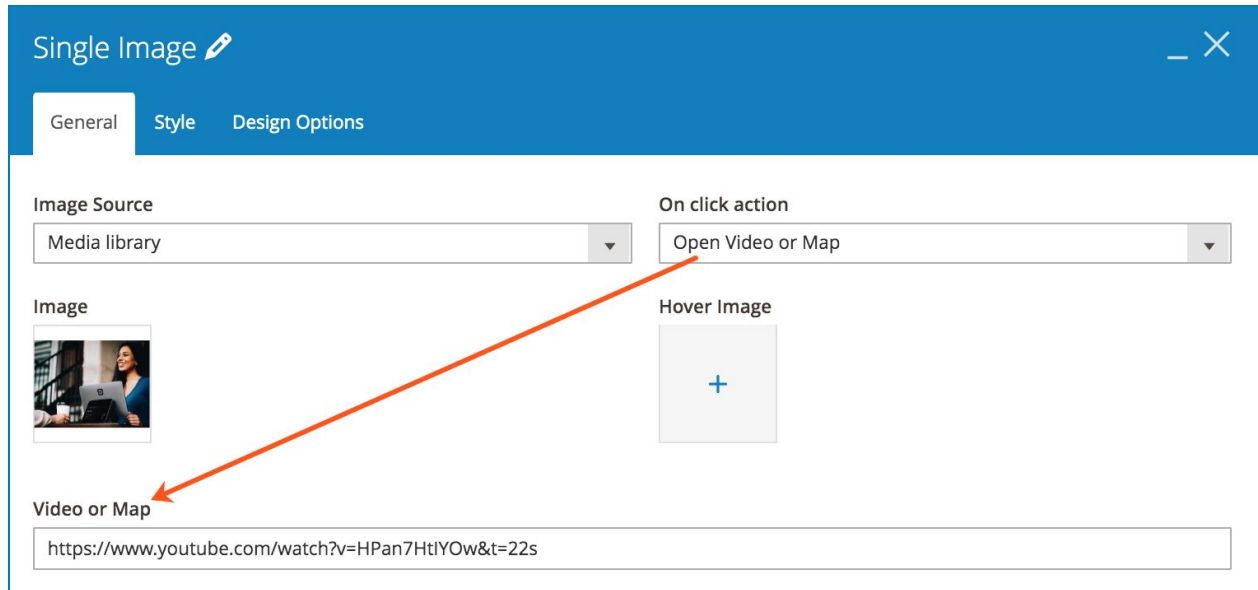
>> Open the image in a Magnific Popup:



>> Open Custom Link:





>> Open Video or Map:



- Set **Image Style** as Default, Outline, Shadow1, Shadow2 or 3D Shadow.
- Set **Image Hover Effect** as Zoom In, Lift Up or Zoom Out.
- Customize **Image Width** and **Image Height**.
- Enter image **Alternative Text** & **Image ID**.
- Enter image **Title** and **Description**.
- **Content Position**: choose position for image content (Title & Description).
- Set **Content Alignment** as Left, Right or Center.
- **Display Content on Hover**: if enabled, image Title and Description is only displayed on hover.

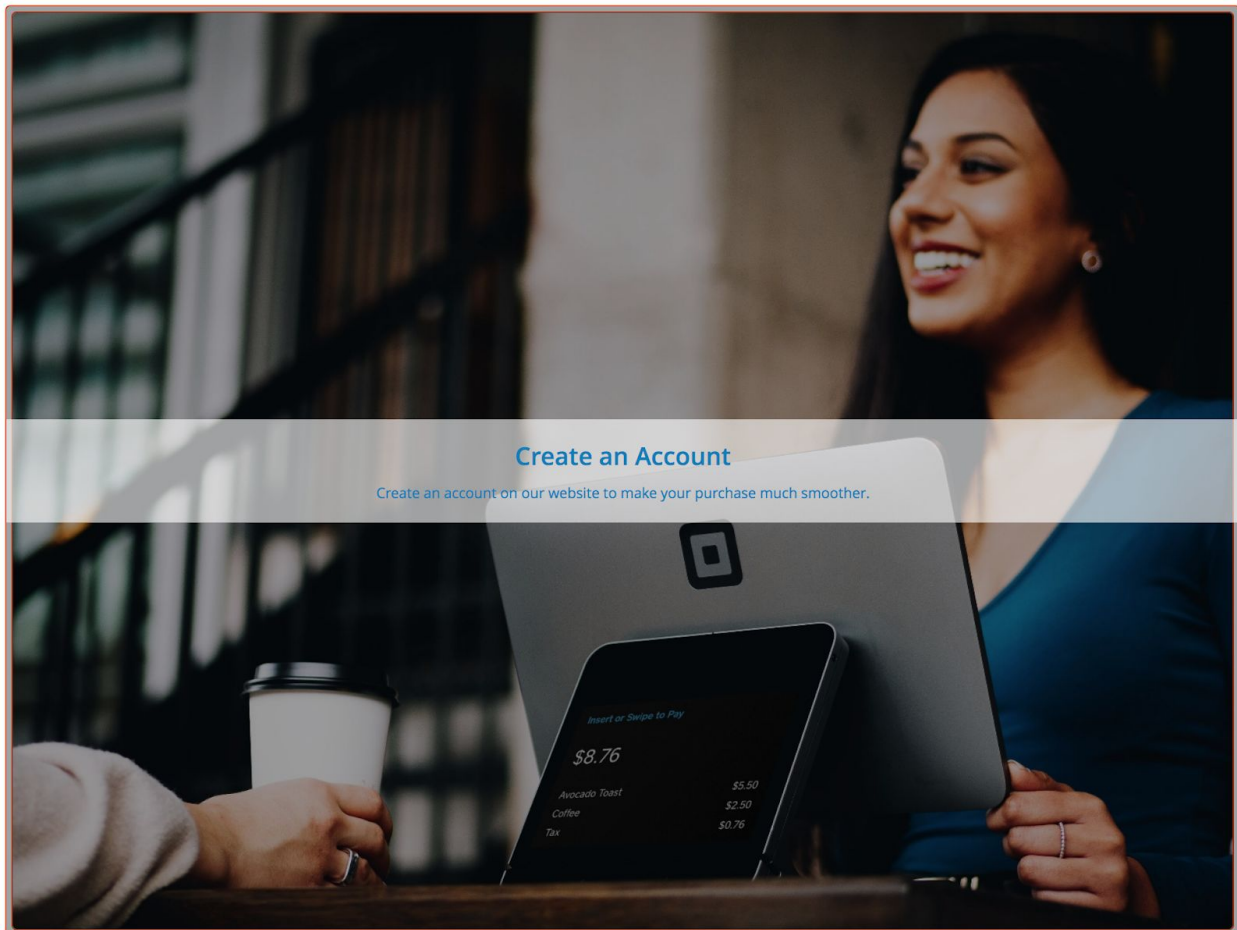

- **Content Padding:** set padding between content (Title & Description) and the container.
- **Content Fullwidth:** set the content to cover full width of the image.
- Set **Text Color** (color for title & description) and **Background Color** of the text.
- Specify **Title Font Size**, **Title Font Weight**, **Description Font Size** and **Description Font Weight**.

- Set **Border Radius**, **Border Width**, **Border Style** & **Border Color** (border that surrounds the image).
- **Overlay Color**: choose color that covers the image.
- **Hover Overlay Color**: choose overlay color on hover (you need to set **Overlay Color** so that this hover overlay color works).




V) Multi-Store & Language Support

Login & Registration Page extension supports multiple stores and languages. It means you can apply different layouts for login & registration pages on different store views.

Please follow these steps to set layout for each store view.

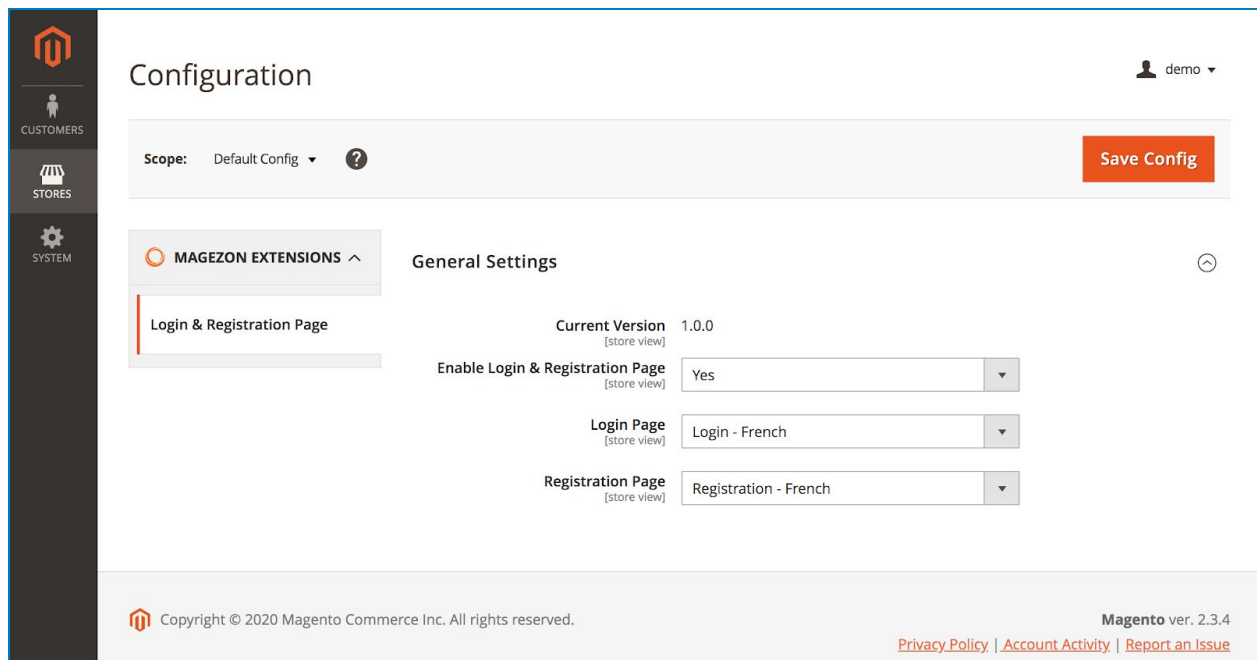
* Suppose that your website has 2 store views: English & France. And you created 2 layouts for the login page, one for English store view and the other for France store view. Similarly, you have 2 layouts for the registration page, one for English store view and the other for France store view.



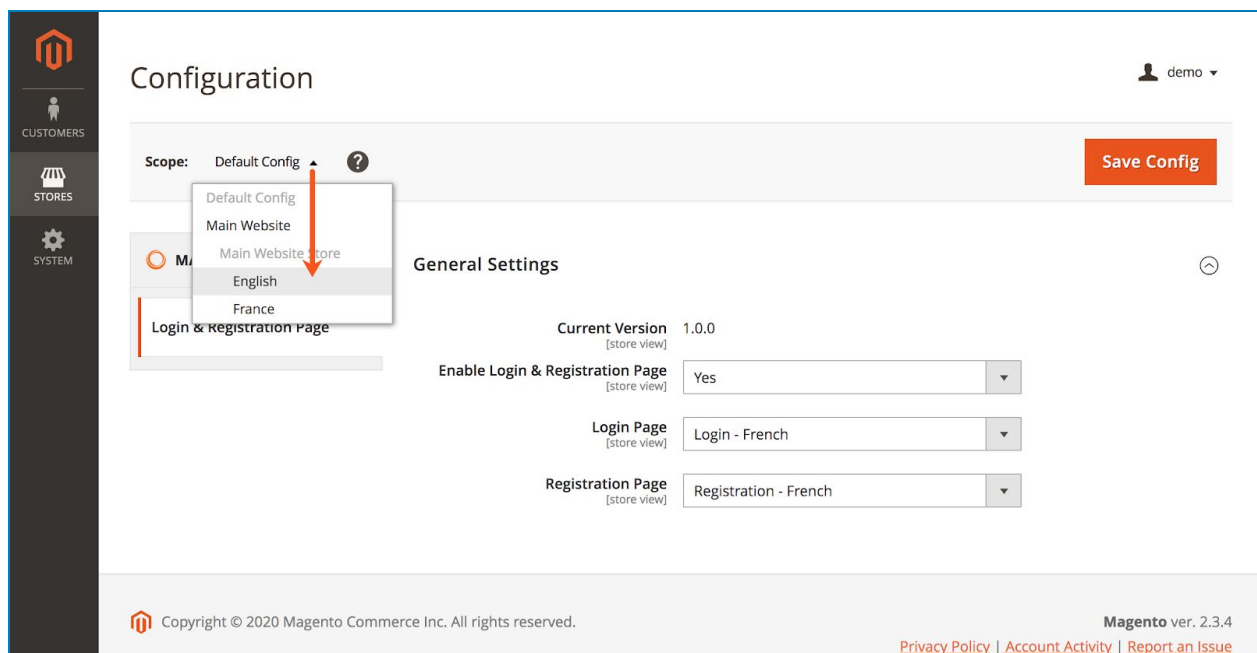

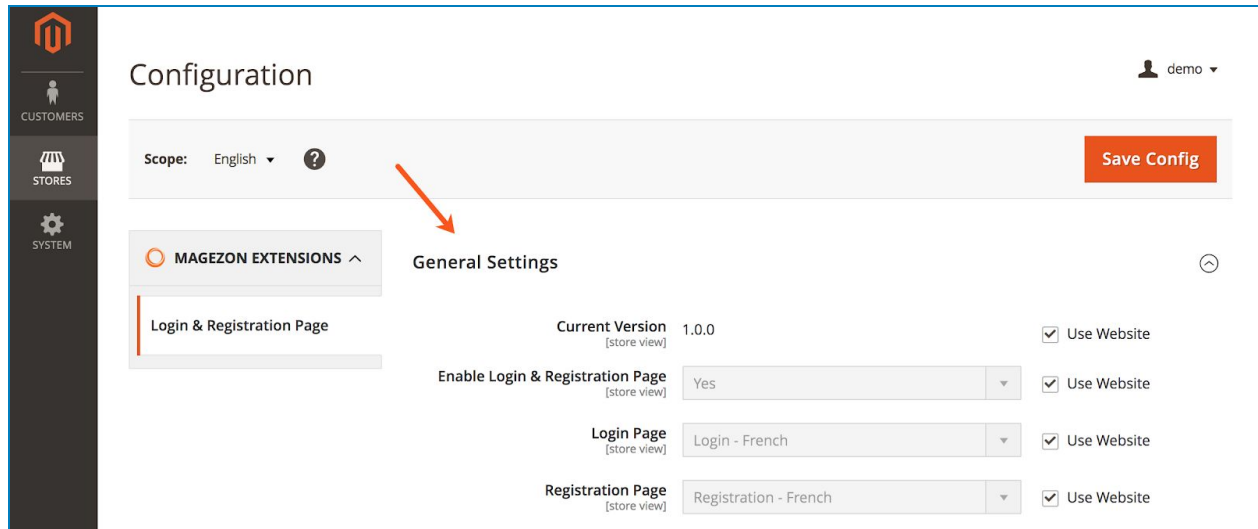
Step 1: Go to **Store > Settings > Configuration**. On the left panel, span **MAGEZON EXTENSIONS** and choose **Login & Registration Page**.



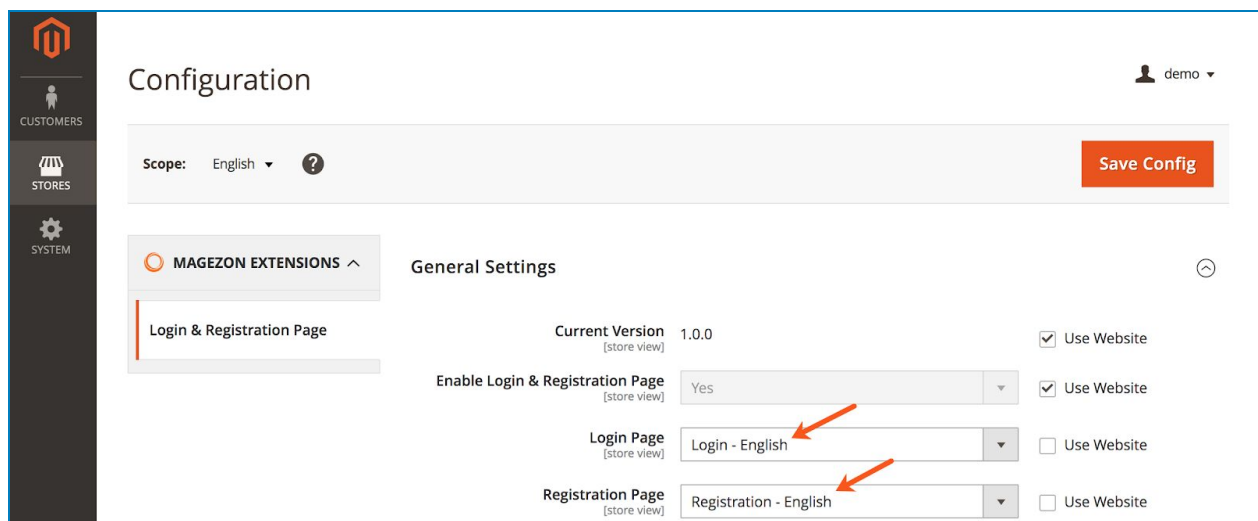
Step 2: Click the drop-down icon next to Default Config and choose one specific store view. For example, we choose English.



Step 3: After you choose a specific store view, **General Settings** section will be like this:




Untick **Use Website** checkbox next to Login Page and Registration Page fields to be able to edit. In this case, we choose **Login - English** layout for Login Page and **Registration - English** for Registration Page.




Take similar steps for France store view. Remember to **Save Config** after making changes.
