

Display Rules Plugin for Magezon Page Builder

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I) Introduction

Display Rules plugin helps configure the content display for your desired customer groups in multiple time ranges. Moreover, it lets you show/hide content for different store views.

Key features of **Display Rules** plugin:


- Support All Elements
- Flexibly Select Customer Group to Display
- Display in Multiple Store Views
- Set Unlimited Ranges Of Time
- Works Well With all Magezon Builder Extensions

Display Rules is a plugin of [Magezon Page Builder](#) extension. Please pre-install Magezon Page Builder. After that, install Display Rules plugin and it will be integrated with existing page builder on your website.


II) Where to find the Plugin

After the plugin is installed, you will find a tab named Display Rules in every Element's Setting pop-up.

Heading element




Or Single Image



III) How to use

After turning on **Enable Display Rules** button, you'll find the following settings:



1. Show/hide content to Customer Groups

1.1 Show content to targeted Customer Groups


First, in the **Type** field, select **Show** option.

If you want to show the Single Image to **All Groups** of Customers. Choose it.



Or, set it to be displayed for the new visitors by choosing NOT LOGGED IN option:




Now, you can set it to display for any group just by choosing the listed options. You can choose **more than one** group or even all the groups listed in the **Customer Groups** field.

1.2 Hide content to targeted Customer Groups


To hide the content for specific group(s), everything is just the same. The only difference is to select **Hide** option from the drop-down of **Type** field.



For instance, hide the **Slider** to customers who are NOT LOGGED IN. Let's configure it!




And the result be like:

being hidden**




After being hidden




2. Show/hide content to Store View

2.1 Show content to Store View

Easily set up the content to be displayed in different Store Views. Try applying **English** store view for the **Recent Reviews** element.




And the result in the front:



2.2 Hide content to Store View

Similarly, you can also hide the content using the **Store View** field.


Try setting the **Single image** like below

And the result be like:




Note: The **Store View** rule must be set with the **Customer Groups** field at the same time. It means you have to select values in both fields while configuring.

3. Show/hide content in time period(s)

3.1 Show/Hide content in a period of time

Hit the **Add** button and set the time range using **From** & **To** fields



3.2 Show/Hide content in multiple periods of time

If you have more than 1 time range, set them respectively.

Set as many time periods as you want to display/hide the content in special events or promotion campaigns.

Note: The **Time Period** Rule should be combined with the **Customer Groups** & **Store View** fields. It means you have to select values in those fields before adding time ranges.
